




WILD @ LIFE

Globally we are having hard times with the pandemic. We have made our Public Statement last month and we have already started a social media campaign with #stopwildlifecrime #covid19, which is a success.

Our projects are suffering. With the border closures, Angola and Zambia cannot get any help from abroad. Mission Caíta, Angola is on total lock-down. We have 5 primates and a moustached guenon under our care .



We have saved Jacka, a 7 months old baby from a restaurant and Caliando, a 3 years old male from a a container in a miserable situation. These were the last rescues we could make, and Angola went on lock-down the day after that.

It is very hard to continue our sanctuary project in such conditions, as work has totally stopped. We cannot even get the basic food and medicine for our orphans.

To have a quick remedy, we have started adoption program. If you are interested in adopting an orphan in need, this would be the most important time to do it. You can also make the adoption for a loved one. We will send the certificate to the person you want.

Monthly costs are around \$200 so with \$35 you can cover the weekly food cost! We need you more in these hard covid19 times. All border are locked and is harder to get what the orphans need.



We are sure you receive a lot of appeals lately so we would not keep asking a lot of things. We could buy Lucerne for our 9 elephants under lock-down but Angola is struggling even more.

Wild@Life is always working against poaching, wet markets and bushmeat. These are the main factors of pandemics ground zero. Our law enforcement work is needed more than ever, since it has now been seen worldwide that wildlife abuse and consumption can harm anyone in this planet.
